## **Summary:**

ODI has received ten VOQ's regarding sudden loss of headlights in the subject vehicles while driving. Six of the VOQ's were reported during 2008. The failures allegedly occurred without warning and intermittently. In response to the failures, some of the complainants pulled over and waited until the headlight function returned while others continued driving without headlights.

It is noted that some of the complainants stated that the headlights' "flash to pass" feature remained operational. This feature is engaged by pulling back and holding the multi-function turn signal actuator arm.

EWR field reports indicate replacing the lighting control module may have resolved the headlight problems in the subject vehicles.
